- ethical and legal aspects of oral history research (GDPR);
- oral history and modern technologies in times of COVID-19.

We especially welcome interdisciplinary contributions with theoretical, methodological, ethical or practical reflection of qualitative research using the interview method during various crises (or research focused on witness reflection of these crises), similar to outputs from ongoing or completed student research and projects using the oral history method.
